

ORDINANCE NO. 1434

AN ORDINANCE CREATING SECTION 1-837 OF THE MARION CITY CODE PERTAINING TO MEETINGS TO INCLUDE PARTICIPATION VIA ELECTRONIC MEANS INCLUDING TELEPHONE, VIDEO, OR OTHER TELECOMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGIES, BY MEANS OF WHICH ALL PERSONS PARTICIPATING IN THE MEETING CAN HEAR ONE ANOTHER, AND SUCH PARTICIPATION IN A MEETING SHALL CONSTITUTE PRESENCE IN PERSON AT THE MEETING.

WHEREAS, The Elected Governing Body of the City of Marion, Kansas have determined the addition of this enhancement to the Code of Procedure is beneficial and advisable for the citizens, employees, elected officials and participants in the local governmental process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MARION, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: Addition of Chapter1, Article 8, Section 37

1-837 Meetings by Telephone or Video Conferencing

Members of the Governing Body of the City of Marion may participate in a Regular or Special meeting of the Governing Body by means of conference telephone or similar communications equipment, by means of which all persons participating in the meeting can hear one another, and such participation in a meeting shall constitute presence in person at the meeting. Minutes shall reflect action taken at such meeting and individuals participating via electronic communications.

SECTION 2: Addition of Chapter 1, Article 1, Section 02 (ab)

Electronic Participation

Members of the Governing Body of the City of Marion may participate in a Regular or Special meeting of the Governing Body by means of conference telephone or similar communications equipment, by means of which all persons participating in the meeting can hear one another, and such participation in a meeting shall constitute presence in person at the meeting.

Ordinance Incorporated by reference Under the Provisions of K.S.A. 12-3009 through 12-3012, and K.S.A. 12-3301 and 12-3302.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by the governing body of the City, approval by the Mayor and publication of a summary hereof certified as legally accurate and sufficient by the City Attorney in the Official Newspaper of the City.

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Marion, Kansas, through the petition presented and the findings of the Public Officer, does hereby declare a public hearing for the Owner(s), the Owner(s) agent, any lien holder of record and any occupant of the structure listed below may appear and show cause why the structure should not be condemned and ordered repaired or demolished as per Marion City Code 8-203.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION: SOUTHERN ADDITION (MARION), PRT BLK 31 SOUTHERN ASSITION BEWGINNING 50' S NE/C BLOCK 31 THEN WEST 200' SOUTH 58' EAST 200' NORTH 58' TO POINT OF BEGINNING. SOUTHERN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF MARION, KANSAS. Commonly known as 305 S. Lincoln, Marion, Kansas.
